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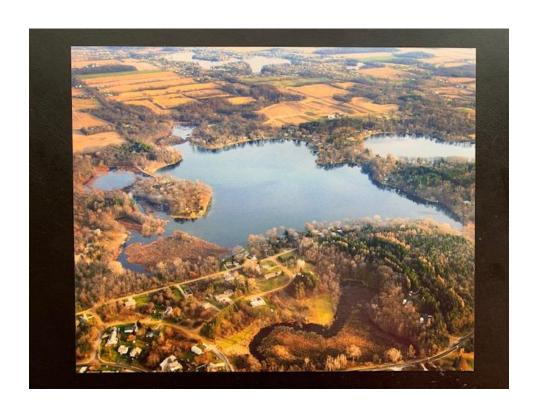

SAD Update

Petition

 70% of owners signed SAD petition representing 75% of frontage.

Informal public hearing

 Was conducted to better gauge support for our project. We were well represented at the meeting. The board did not make a decision at that point whether to move forward. They had to verify petition signatures.

Agreement by Township Board

 Remember, the Township board is under no obligation to establish a special assessment district and will weigh all options and information before coming to a decision.

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Sad Update

First public hearing

- Was cancelled in March due to Covid 19.
- Township has incurred \$5,000 in expenses to begin process.
- Township will gauge SAD support by owners who attend meeting. Important that you attend.
- Creation of special assessment roll
- Second public hearing
 - Township to hear from residents included in SAD.
- SAD is created!
